Validating XHTML

- Struggling with Validating?
 - * No blank lines at top of page
 - * DOCTYPE on two lines
 - * All lower case HTML tags
 - * Three special self-closing tags
 - `<hr />`
 - `

XHTML 1.0

- Other errors
 - * Nothing can “hang out” on its own
 - * Enclose these tags inside paragraphs or divisions:
 - `
`
 - ``
 - * Align is deprecated
 - Use the style attribute in your `<p>` tag:
`style="text-align: center;"`



XHTML 1.0

- Add a blank line:
* `<p></p>`



XHTML 1.0

- Why do all this effort validating to XHTML Strict 1.0?
 - * Validating makes sure your code works in more browsers more of the time
 - * Because AOL no longer supports HTML 4.01, so it's gone
 - * We want you to have the most current skillsXML is eXtended Markup Language



XHTML 1.0

- Why do all this effort validating to XHTML Strict 1.0?
 - * XHTML—the X means XML
 - XHTML is XML compliant
 - * XML is eXtended Markup Language
 - Make your own tags
 - Usually agreed upon by industries
 - * XHTML is the set of tags approved by W3C
