## Notes:

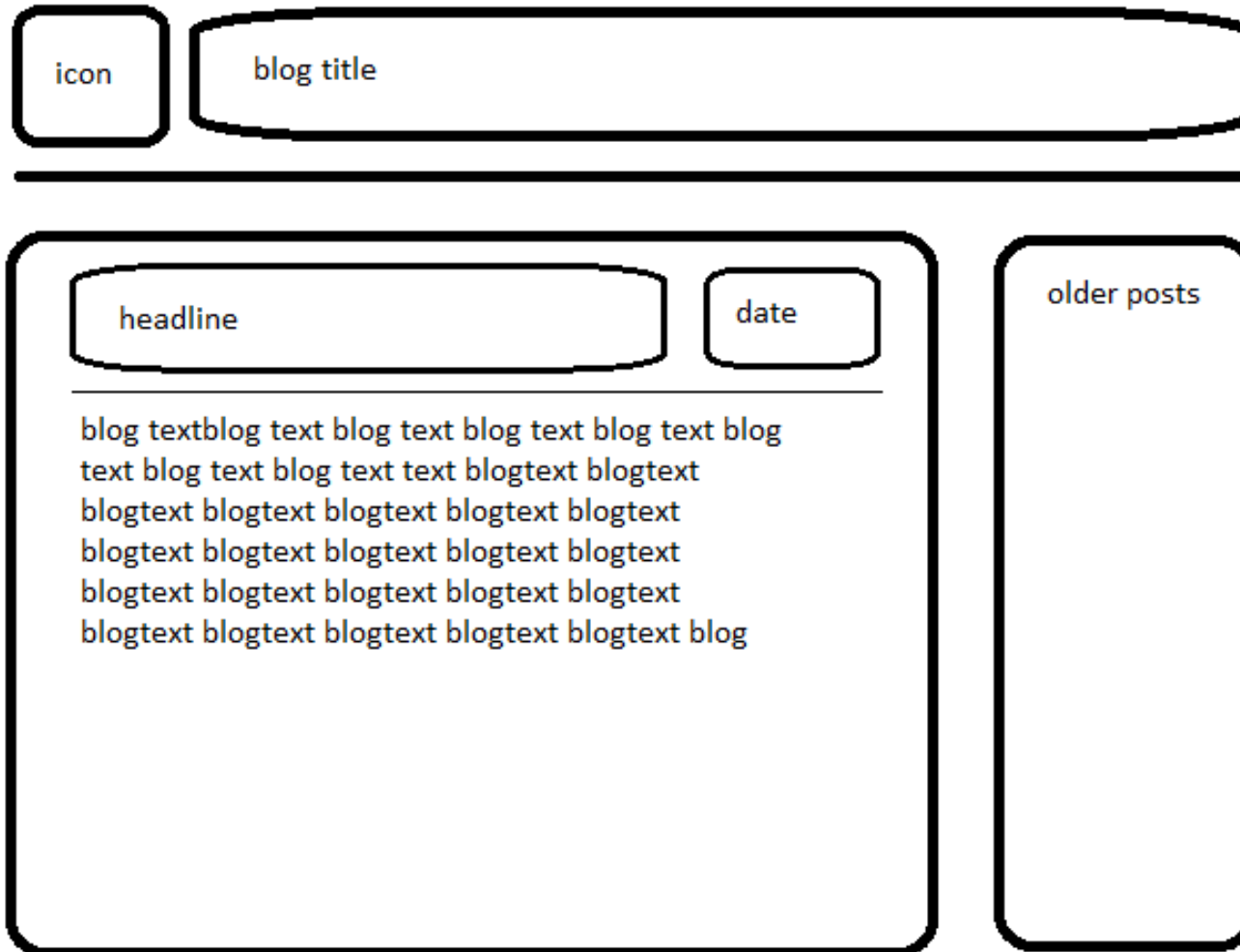
Every row of columns should go in a div of rows.

Every row is 12 units wide.

Give divs a class of span# to make them take # rows.

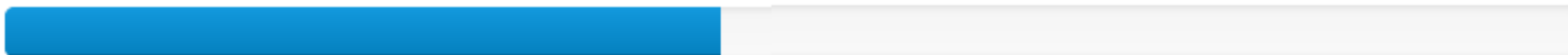
