

How to Install SVN (Correctly)

You have 2 options

I. Eclipse plugin: **Subclipse** (all OS's)

1. Install Subclipse

Open Eclipse

'Help' menu -> 'Install New Software'

'Add' button

Name: Subclipse

Location: http://subclipse.tigris.org/update_1.8.x

Next, Agree, Finish, etc

2. Checkout your repository

'File' -> 'Import' -> 'Checkout from SVN repository'

Create new repo (this will connect you to a repo you specify)

URL: `svn+ssh://attu.cs.washington.edu/projects/instr/13wi/cse331/Your-`

CSE-NetID/REPOS

Correction made to the above. The section slides are incorrect.

On the next screen, make sure your username matches your CSE Net ID and use your CSE password as your password.

II. Stand-alone clients:

Command Line (Linux, Mac, Windows)

1) Find instructions for your OS here

2) checkout your repo

```
svn checkout svn+ssh://attu.cs.washington.edu/projects/instr/13wi/
cse331/Your-CSE-NetID/REPOS
```

or if your CSE NetID is not your local user name:

```
svn+ssh://Your-CSE-NetID@attu.cs.washington.edu/projects/instr/13wi/
cse331/Your-CSE-NetID/REPOS
```

TortoiseSVN (Windows)

A standalone GUI client.
