Resubmission Policy

Question Sets If you receive a score of check-minus, you can resubmit your question set for regrading when you submit your final binder at the end of the quarter.

Labs If you receive a score of 1 or 2 on any section of the Labs, you can resubmit your lab for regrading when you submit your final binder at the end of the quarter.

For either Question Sets or Labs, clearly write "Regrade Me" or some such other message on the paper so we are sure to regrade it.

Keep in mind that when you submit your Final Binder, we will also have copies of everyone else's Final Binder. So please do not even consider turning in someone else's work.

Regrading Policy

If you believe that your original submission of a Lab deserves a higher grade than you received, then you can discuss this with the instructor during office hours or by making an appointment. Please come with a written explanation as to why your lab deserves higher scores. The instructor will *not* consider regrading via email or discuss regrades before or after class. If you have questions about your grade, you should visit the TA's during their office hours.
