Research Topic

Communities in South King County experience disproportionately negative health outcomes. Members of these communities are both diverse and resource-constrained. These communities experience diabetes rates that are 4 times higher than surrounding areas.

Our Solution & Process

We are adapting Digital Green's concept for creating and producing videos. With Global 2 Local we have been developing a process that enables community members to create health-promoting videos to serve their own communities. Our first videos are focused on healthy living for diabetes prevention.

April 2012


Hands-on workshop at Global 2 Local with health promoters and program coordinators from the Community Schools Collaborative.
