Designing User Interfaces (UIs) for Low-Literate Users.

This assignment involves creating the visual elements including Icons and Images, which will be used in your Programming Assignment 3 and answering the questions listed below. The goal of this assignment is to enable you to brainstorm on ideas of how User Interfaces (UIs) are designed for low-literate users.

For the purpose of the assignment, you will be required to create individual elements for each icon that goes on the User Interface (UI) and answer the following questions.

Designing the Icons: Karandaaz Pakistan made a UI Toolkit for the Mobile Money Interfaces for low-literate users. The [Toolkit](#) is shared with the assignment. Design the Icons keeping the sociocultural considerations in mind, for your selected country. They should be easy to understand.

Answer the following questions in less than 500 words:

- **Question 1 :** Write about your assumptions of the levels of literacy of your target users and the expectations of the users that you considered while making these Images and Icons for the assignment. Also, share what the icons depict and how your design matches the needs of your end-users.
- **Question 2 :** In your previous assignments, you have been asked to select a country. Share to what extent did your country of choice influence your design of the Icons and Images based on the country of your selection.
- **Question 3 :** On Monday, Oct 29th, UW CSE Digital Financial Services Research Group hosted the fourth DFS Workshop on the topic of "Gender & DFS." Your class was invited to attend some or all of the Workshop. You are required to write a short summary of the talk(s) you were able to attend. You can select one or more talks and write a summary.
