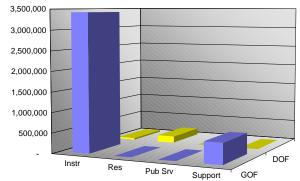

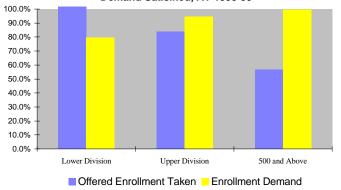

Budget By Program & Source - FY 2000

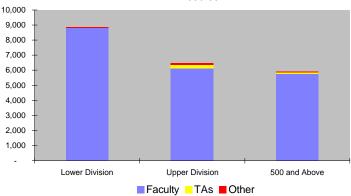


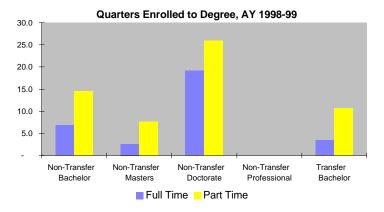
% Offered Enrollment Taken and % Enrollment Demand Satisified, AY 1998-99

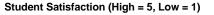


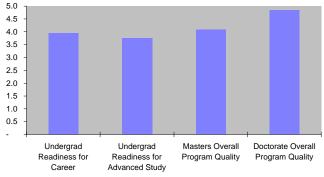

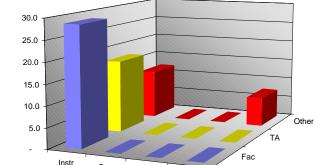
